> He then presented his suggestions and recommendations for further improvement of institutional progress.

Suggestions by Mr. Ganesh, IQAC member

> To provide add on certifications to BCA students on 'Generative AI' as in today's tech-driven environment, understanding Generative AI improves problem-solving and creativity and enables an edge in sophisticated technology, making them more marketable. Learning Generative AI encourages innovation and prepares students to contribute to the fast-changing field of computer science.

➤ B.Com and BBA students to be provided with certification on 'Fundamentals of Al' that equipes them with Al technologies required for data-driven decision-making, improving their analytical and strategic skills. He added that Al skills are need of the hour to for young graduates to stay competitive and adaptive in the dynamic corporate world.

➤ For thorough understanding of stock markets functioning, exposing students to virtual trading investment platforms (for eg'Moneybhai.com)' is highly essential for commerce and management students, as these experiences provide practical insights, enabling students to grasp the intricacies of financial markets and hone their decision-making skills in investing.

> Mr. Ganesh recommended organising intra or intercollege 'Hackathons' on setting up Startup ecosystem through entrepreneurship club and conducting activities on areas of Fintech and technology.

> Introduction of minor subjects such as macroeconomics and geopolitics to equips students to gain knowledge on the intricate relationships of world economies, fostering a broader perspective on global affairs.

> The flip classroom concept to be encouraged among faculty as a teaching pedagogy that promotes interactive discussions and problem-solving skills. He added that this approach builds a student-centred learning environment and strengthens critical thinking abilities among students.


Suggestions given by Dr. Ravi Shankar, IQAC member (In person)


- ➤ Dr. Ravishankar, suggested "Gap Analysis" to identify any discrepancies, ensuring relevance, addressing trends, and meeting evolving needs and added that gap analysis enhances curriculum effectiveness, aligns courses with industry demands, preparing students comprehensively for future challenges.
- > He added that to bridge identified gaps in curriculum, value-added programs must be offered to students to ensure that they gain practical knowledge that aligns with evolving demands, enhancing their overall educational experience.
- > He then suggested the implementation of outcome-based education to define specific learning outcomes and aligning instructional methods to achieve them.


Discussion on the feasible action plan for implementation based on the suggestions and feedback of the members.
