THE SCRIPT WHICH TELLS THE STORY OF INITIATING TOASTMASTERS CLUB – CURATED BY PROF. CHAITRA N S MURTHY

Let us begin not just with applause but with the story.

A story from a time when a great bridge was being built not of stone or a-cement but of purpose unity, determination and shared dream.

Once upon a time, a war was about to begin. Not one of ego, but of righteousness. Lord Rama had to cross the mighty ocean to reach Lanka and rescue Sita. But how?
